- All sales final with cash or check. Sorry, no credit cards.

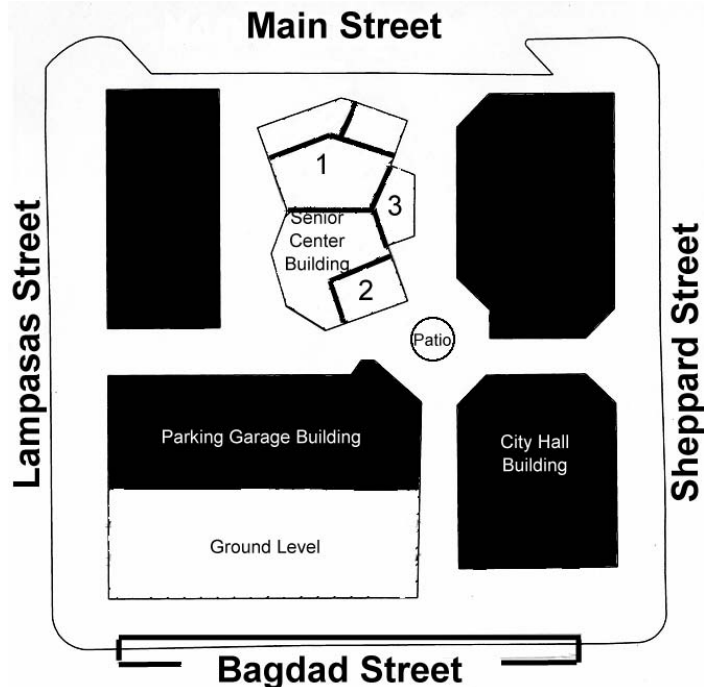
Raffle Rules:
